# **Public Health Update**

Families are reminded to please update your child/children's immunization records with Niagara Region Public Health. You may do so by clicking this <u>link</u>. Any students who have not completed the immunization reporting may be issued an Order of Suspension by NRPH this August. # **Updating Medical Information / Forms**

Each school year, we must update medical information for all students. Please arrange for your child's doctor to complete the required forms. If you need the medical forms, please contact your child's teacher (email address is

firstname.lastname@niagaracatholic.ca) or call the office.

- Anaphylaxis: If your child has a severe allergy and may need medication, their doctor must complete forms for both emergency protocols and medication administration.
- **Medication:** We cannot administer any medication without a doctor's orders. This applies to all medical conditions.
- Specific Conditions: Students with Asthma, Diabetes, Epilepsy, or other medical needs must also have updated condition-specific protocols completed.

# **Lunch Delivery**

- We are a Nut Safe facility. This means no peanut/tree nut products/nutella are permitted at school. There are many students who have life-threatening allergies, so please be considerate.
- Label lunches: If you are dropping off or having lunch delivered, please clearly label it with your child's first and last name.

- Delivery services: Make sure delivery drivers have your child's name for the drop-off.
- Specialty Food Days: Confirm your orders in SchoolCashOnline.
