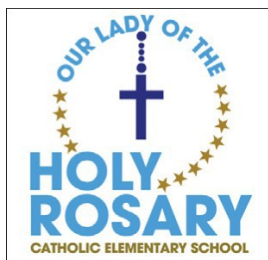


# Weekly Update
