




Niagara Catholic Parent Portal Instructions

Parents can access the portal through https://niagaracatholic.ca/reportcards and then select the child's school.



The username is the email address the school has on file and the one that was entered to previously create the account.

If you can't remember your password there is an option on the school page to request a password change
