








November Reflection



GRADE 8 INFORMATION EVENING AT DENIS MORRIS HIGH SCHOOL

Advanced Placement (AP) is a program designed to challenge secondary school students academically. Advanced Placement (AP) exams allow high school students in Gr. 12 who excel on these exams the opportunity to gain university credits while still in high school. These exams are written in May and are usually 2-3 hours in length. What sets AP apart is its rigorous curriculum, which goes beyond the standard high school curriculum and delves into more complex and in-depth subject matter. Students

taking AP and APP courses will be assessed and evaluated on the Ontario Curriculum; the AP curriculum is built into the course as an enhancement to the Ontario Curriculum. Gr.9's who enroll in the AP program would have a secondary pathway of taking APP courses in Gr.9 -11 then take the AP course (and exam) in Gr. 12.

Our Advanced Placement Preparation Information Session is scheduled for November 27 at 6:30 pm at Denis Morris. Any students and families who might be interested in the AP program are encouraged to join us to find out more on November 27th. Student Services will also explain pathway selection including APP during the upcoming Gr. 8 day on Tuesday, November 26th and during our course selection presentations in December.

Niagara Region Public Health Dental Program

Niagara Region Public Health Dental Program will be offering <u>dental screening</u> to grades JK, SK, 2, 4 and 7 on January 13 and 14, 2025. A registered dental hygienist will take a quick look in the child's mouth using a sterilized dental mirror and light.


