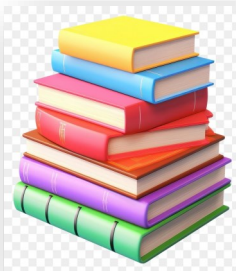

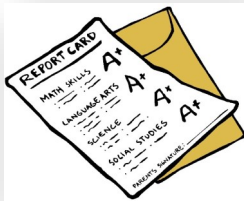
## **Yearbook**

### **Fight the Bite!**

Ticks, mosquitos and rabid animals have no boundaries and can be a risk to you and your family when

walking to and from school or work, waiting at the bus stop, family trips, and while playing in the yard at home or at the park.

Protect yourself and your family from West Nile Virus:

- Reduce standing water where mosquitoes breed
- Cover up, wear long sleeved shirts, long pants, hats socks and shoes
- Repair any damaged window screens
- Use insect repellants containing DEET or Icardin (follow manufacturer's instructions)

Reduce the risk of Lyme disease:

- Wear light coloured clothing to help spot ticks
- Use insect repellants containing DEET or Icardin (follow manufacturer's instructions)
- Check yourself, your children and pets for ticks after being outdoors
- Cut your grass and dispose of leaf litter where ticks can live

Prevent rabies:

- Vaccinate your pets
- Do not feed or approach any wild, stray or strange animals
- Do not trap, transport, keep or pet any wild animals
- Do not try and nurse sick animals back to health

## **North or 60 Project**

In our May newsletter we looked at a June social justice initiative called the North of 60 project where as a school community we will be collecting Campbell's Vegetable Soup cans that we will then hand over to St. Vincent De Paul Society who will be filling a 20 foot sea container with a variety of non perishable foods that have been assigned to each school. This sea container is then shipped to Naujaat Nanuvut otherwise known as Repulse Bay. These residents live off the land with fishing and hunting being a large part of their source of food. In this area 40 families are in need of our help and each year the Niagara Catholic District School Board takes action by inviting schools to be part of this great cause. We ask that students bring in what they can but only Campbell's Vegetable soup. Other schools have other specific items they are collecting so these brothers and sisters of ours in Repulse Bay can have a variety of items to help them.
