Cell Phone Use in Schools

Students who bring their cell phones to school must have the phone stored out of view and turned off or onto silent mode during the instructional day. They may only use it if their teacher permits it for learning, for health or medical purposes, or to support special education needs.



If a teacher sees a cell phone that is not stored out of view, students will be required to hand in their device in for the

instructional day. The cell phone will be placed, by the student, in a secure storage area designated by the principal.

If a student refuses to hand in their personal mobile device, the Ministry requires that the student be sent to the principal's office. Consequences for failing to hand in their phone is at the principal's discretion.

School boards are now required to disable access to social media platforms on school networks and board devices. This is intended to limit the number of interruptions in class and to benefit the mental health and well-being of students. Niagara Catholic already blocks access to some social media sites. Now all will be unavailable to students on the board network during the school day.

Safe Arrival

Student achievement is linked to student attendance. School staff and parents/guardians have a shared responsibility to promote student attendance. Excused and unexcused absences can add up quickly and affect student learning.

Niagara Catholic uses the Safe Arrival system to record a student's absence. Parents/guardians use Safe Arrival to report their child's late arrival or absence quickly and conveniently.

Electronic absence reporting also ensures that parents can be notified quickly if their child is not at school.

Dress Code

Dress Code

1. Compliance with the Standardized Dress Code Policy is a condition of registration and attendance in an elementary school within the Niagara Catholic District School Board.



- 2. It is the expectation that students wear the elementary standardized dress code items properly and in compliance with expectations throughout the school day and at all activities and events as representatives of the school and/or Board.
- 3. Alternate Dress Days will be determined by the school Principal for specific events or activities and communicated in advance to students, parents and guardians.
- 4. All students are expected to wear the elementary standardized dress code when on field trips unless approved by the Principal.

At all times, students should dress in a manner suitable for attendance at a Catholic elementary school. Students are asked to cooperate with these expectations. Those students who do not cooperate will be expected to make suitable changes and/or will be sent home.

Dress Code items can be purchased at stores such as: Walmart, Old Navy, Children's Place, Giant Tiger and others. It's easiest to remember, white of navy-blue tops and navy-blue bottoms. Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

- Enter Your Child's Name & Birth Date
- d) Select Continue
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select Continue
- f) Your child has been added to your account

Communication Between Home & School

The Ministry of Education has given school boards new requirements on how to communicate with parents who have questions, concerns, or complaints. This information will also be shared on the Parents section of the Board website and school websites in time for the start of the new school year. The process is outlined below:

- Parents/guardians should expect a response to a concern within two business days.
- If parents have a question about a classroom-related matter, such as curriculum, homework, classroom behavior, or specific incidents, please contact the child's teacher.
- If the parent cannot resolve the issue at the classroom level and/or have a question about school procedures, extracurricular activities, or safety concerns, please contact the school Principal.
- For issues unresolved at the school level or issues related to Niagara Catholic policies, procedures, resource allocation, or other concerns, please contact the Superintendent of Education assigned to St. John Henry Newman Catholic Elementary School.
