OPEN QUESTIONS / COMMENTS:

- E. Forbes was appreciative of the staff for the support and hard work within this unique year. Everyone was in agreement!
- B. Palujanskas explained that the increase in Provincial COVID cases may increase the number of online learners.
- Outdoor equipment may evolve into safe usage, which will need monitoring. We go by the Polies from the Board. Meeting tomorrow will update principals on new procedures and policies.
- Calendar in lieu of the calendar, Mr. P is providing families with emails community messages. Suggestion to hold off on the calendar may be a good idea.
- More QUESTIONS?
- M. Febbraro safety in the morning crossing the Service Rd. with walkers and bike riders, he is seeing more students crossing the roads. This is concerning due to traffic and drivers there may be a need for a study done at the busy sections. Mr. Palujanskas will contact the people necessary in order to inquire about a study.
- There have been multiple times when traffic is heavy, cars are making rolling stops at the stop sign, and speeding by this is concerning.
- Do we have enough bike space/capacity now that there are more walkers/riders? Maybe more racks would encourage more riders.
- Parking when it rains, there will be more drop offs and more cars in the kiss and ride. Mr. Palujanskas pursued the use of the Church next door. However, the Board requires an insurance policy that in quite lengthy. An issue may be the 'accident' component when it is slippery.
- M. Febbraro asked if the last bus that blocks the sidewalk on Olive St. can be removed or changed. Mr. Palujanskas will see how it will look tomorrow.
- Question is the staffroom closed? Can parents drop off food/treats? For World teachers Day, can parents drop off coffee? Mr. Palujanksas explained that common spaces have limited capacity for teachers.
