#### 3. Chair Report

i) Fundraising Update

Lottery Calendar of prizes for May, 2021.

Mr. Venzon will send an email to all families letting them know that this will be our main fundraiser for this year, as we will not be having Fun Night, Trivia, etc. This email will ask families for any donations in the form of gift cards of \$25.00 or more from local businesses. These donations of gift cards will be collected until March 12<sup>th</sup>.

Next, we will see what cards come in and backfill any needed cards to fill calendar with each day \$25.00 card draw, and bonus days that include more than the 1 card prize... (we can discuss and decided what this will look like once we get all the cards).

We will then ask our families to sell calendars to people they know... maybe a goal of 10 sold per family. We can sell calendars from March 22 until the end of April.

Calendars will be posted somewhere for families to see (need to decide on best place). Winners will be contacted.

Draws will begin on May 1<sup>st</sup>... Winners names may be drawn more than once, so there are 31 chances to win. We will see what bonus days we can include. Each calendar would have a number, and families could send Mr. Venzon an email with Calendar # purchased and name. Each family collects from people who buy, and then the family makes the payment on School Cash Online.

  - Mr. Venzon talked about the staff meeting today and the need to promote problem solving and critical thinking in kids. "Old-school" teaching with worksheets that promotes rote memorization of facts is not as valuable in Math, for example, when working with numbers. Mr. Venzon presented 2 examples of MathUp School Improvement. The first was an organization template for kids to work on additive decomposition and the second was related to multiplicative decomposition.
