B. CHAIR'S REPORT / PRESENTATIONS

- Health & Safety Protocols / School Re-Opening Plan
 - Reviewed protocols and School Re-Opening Plan
 - Active Screening reports will appear on classroom attendance teachers can send reminders to families who have yet to complete active screening for students who are present
 - Library books can be signed out to bring home. When they are returned, the books will be held in a bin for a week before being recirculated
 - Only essential visitors are permitted in the school
 - Parents can use the desk in the front lobby to drop off items for students
 - Ventilation 4 hepa-filters are placed in rooms with little to no airflow (ie. Classrooms where windows are high)
 - COVID if a student passes the screener, then they are permitted to be sent to school. Students who exhibit symptoms should remain home until symptoms have been absent for 24 hours.
- Mary Ward's By-Laws & CSC Policy Review
 - NCDSB Catholic School Council will be sent to council members and can be found on the NCDSB website
- Niagara Nutrition Partner Grant
 - Mary Ward will have a Grab'n'Go snack program cheese strings, yogurt, bananas, apples. Having students enjoy a snack will be promoted
 - Snack bins will be located at the front office
 - \$547 in the Nutrition account Niagara Nutrition Partners asks that we hold a fundraiser in return for funding. (ie. Portion of funds from a Dance-a-thon, etc)
 - It was mentioned by council that Pre-COVID each class had a bin. There were a variety of snacks in each bin that fell within the nutritional guidelines of sugar per serving

- CSC Dress Code Donations Support
 - Requirement of the Dress Code policy is for schools to support a donation program
 - Mary Ward is asking for donations of any "gently-used" items to support families in the community
 - This will be advertised in the School Newsletter and donations can be sent to school with students
 - The school is open to receiving gift cards to stores that sell dress code items that will be distributed discreetly
- Fundraising Goals
 - Fundraising goals are classroom TVs and outdoor play equipment
 - A new playground could be focus for future fundraising efforts. The old playground was removed due to safety concerns
 - Administration will inquire about the process to obtaining a new playground for the school
 - A sub-committee will be set up

- 3. <u>Faith Theme</u>: "Climbing Mountains Together in Faith" is our Faith Theme for 2021 2022. - 6. <u>**Tiger Spirit Wear**</u>: While following the Elementary Standardized Dress Code policy, we will get pricing from approved Designated Board Suppliers. Once we choose supplier, we will share ordering information with families.
- 7. <u>Meet The Teacher/Classroom Communication</u>: Classroom teachers have chosen their preferred method to reach out to all families regarding a 'Meet the Teacher/Curriculum Night. This was conducted during the week of September 20th. As well, classroom teachers have shared their method of communicating information with families such as Messenger App, NCVLE Announcements, Remind App, etc... As always, feel free to reach out to your child's classroom teacher and plan future opportunities to discuss your child's progress, whether on the phone or virtually.
- 8. <u>Fire Drills/Hold & Secure/Lockdown</u>: Emergency procedures are in place and practiced in all Niagara Catholic schools throughout this school year. We continue to be required to conduct 6 fire drills and 2 hold & secure / lockdown drills each year. This year during our Fire Drills and Hold & Secure, students will remain physical distanced within their environment and classrooms and we will continue to follow both school and provincial health guidelines to ensure everyone's safety. We have completed both our first fire drill and hold & secure. Both practices were well done.
- 9. <u>Terry Fox Walk</u>: Mary Ward once again supported cancer research through 'walking' for Terry Fox. Mrs. Mastracci-Fera led a virtual assembly at 9:30 a.m. as a kickoff and classroom teachers shared information and videos of Terry Fox's journey. Students and staff walked through the neighborhood on September 24, 2021. Mary Ward raised \$1095.00 for the cause. Thank you to our community for donating and thank you to Mrs. Mastracci-Fera for her leadership.
