D. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- 1) **School Fundraising Financial Report** (as of 22/04/2022) Financial report was shared with council members by Mr. Forte.
- 2) **Purchase of Additional Chromebooks** The school has used a portion of its School Generated Funds to purchase additional Chromebooks. These have arrived and will be distributed to classrooms to support student learning and engagement. A sincere thank you is extended to our families for supporting our school fundraisers and lunch days.
- 3) **School Lunch Days** The school continues to provide opportunities for contactless ordering through Pizza Hut (boxed personal pan pizzas) and Subway (personal wrapped subs).
- 4) **Niagara Catholic Parent Involvement Committee (NCPIC) 2022-2023** Information regarding nominations and the application process will be included in our May newsletter.

- 5) **Easter Food Drive for the Grimsby Benevolent Fund** We had an overwhelming response for yet another food drive here at St. John. Together, as a school community, we filled 16 banana boxes with non-perishable items to support those in need in our community.
- 6) **My Life Online** The school is currently working with 'My Life Online' to organize a possible virtual presentation for the parent community this Spring or Fall. 'My Life Online' educates families on assisting their children with managing online platforms responsibly.
- 7) **Sidewalk Along Bus Pick-Up/Drop-Off Lane** The school continues to work with Board personnel in the Facilities Services Department to have a sidewalk installed along the bus pick-up/drop-off lane.
- 8) **Sidewalk Along King Street** The school continues to work with the town and NSTS to have a sidewalk installed along King Street.
- 9) May Long Weekend Families are reminded that there will be *no school on Victoria Day* (Monday, May 23). Classes will resume on Tuesday, May 24.
- 10) **EQAO Digitalized Assessments** The EQAO Assessments in Reading, Writing, and Math are for Grade 3 and Grade 6 students participating in in-person learning. All students who are accessing the Ontario Curriculum are expected to participate in the assessments. Assessments will take place digitally, using school devices from *May 24 27 (Grade 3 students)* and *May 30 June 2 (Grade 6 students)*.
- 11) Catholic Education & Mental Health Week Niagara Catholic elementary and secondary schools will be participating in Catholic Education Week with the theme of "Rebuild, Restore, Renew Together", in conjunction with Mental Health Week, from Monday, May 2, 2022 to Friday, May 6, 2022. Throughout the week, students and staff will participate in prayer services and special activities.
- 12) **'EcoSchools' Initiative** The following events will be taking place throughout the month of May as part of the St. John 'EcoSchools' Initiative...
 - ✓ Waste-Free Lunch Wednesdays: To continue with our ECO initiatives, we will promote Waste-Free Wednesday lunches.
 - ✓ Garden Beautification Day Our 'EcoSchools' Team will be organizing a garden beautification project here at the school on Thursday, May 5. Classes will participate in activities that centre on stewardship and have an opportunity to see the progress of our team's beautification project.
 - ✓ World Bee Day World Bee Day will be recognized and celebrated on Friday, May 20. The purpose of the international day is to acknowledge the role of bees and other pollinators for the ecosystem. At St. John, we will focus on the importance of preserving honeybees and all other pollinators and will be reminded of the significance of bees in providing for the needs of humanity.

- ✓ Big Box of Cards (Spring) The school is currently working with Big Box of Cards to organize a possible Spring fundraiser.

- Niagara Catholic Pandemic Transition Information Page Families are invited to carefully read through this information as we continue to move through a new stage of the global COVID-19 pandemic.
- 2) **Visitors to the School** As we cautiously approach a hopeful return to 'normalcy', school visitors will continue to be restricted out of an abundance of care and consideration for the health and safety of students and school staff.
- 3) **School Sports** The Niagara Catholic District School Board has received approval to run sports within its schools again. Soccer intramurals will run as mini tournaments over the lunch period at St. John Catholic School for interested students in grades 4 6. In addition, the Board is proceeding with Intermediate Soccer and Junior/Intermediate Track and Field.
- 4) **Kiss n' Ride Drop-Off** In an effort to keep our students and staff members safe, families are reminded that when using the Kiss n' Ride drop-off, drivers are asked to please *remain in their vehicle* and have child(ren) exit the vehicle directly onto the sidewalk when it is safe to do so.
- 5) **Kiss n' Ride Pick-Up** To reduce congestion in the Kiss n' Ride line and along Regional Road 81/King Street, Kiss n' Ride students will continue to be dismissed from their classrooms at <u>3:15</u> pm.
- 6) Park & Pick-Up/Drop-Off To avoid congestion in the parking lot and to prevent a back-up of vehicles onto Regional Road 81/King Street, Park & Pick-Up students will be dismissed from their classes at 3:15 pm.
