- 1. Site Plan application sent to Township of Wainfleet. Documents submitted with the application: Application Form; Stage 1 and 2 Archaeological Assessment; Civil Drawings; Elevation Drawings; Land Use Compatibility Study; Landscape Plan; Noise Impact Assessment; Septic System Design Brief; Site Plan; Storm Water Management Design Brief; Transportation Impact Study. Design team is working through the comments received to address the issues and submit responses/revised drawings.
- 2. Approval To Proceed (ATP) to Tender submitted to the Ministry December 16th
- 3. MOE approval of septic design is expected to take 6-12 more months. Environmental Compliance Application will be submitted early April.
- 4. Building permit application sent to Township of Wainfleet on 14 March, 2022.
- 5. Easement agreement with NCDSB and the Diocese for egress/ingress and maintenance across Sugarloaf is being put together by the Lawyer's office.
- 6. Reference plan for the property has been registered.
