Dreambox- Gr 1-3 and KnowledgeHook- Junior/Int grades

- Language
- Haggarty- K-I resources- focusses on phonemic awareness
- Lexia- 13 licenses- Gr 2-8 self-directed computer program that provides lessons based on where they student scored in initial assessment
- Empower 16 students Gr 4-6 work with our ERT for one hour a day
 - o Assists with reading gaps

Science – resources – purchased to support primary PTM teachers

Transition- Gr 8 course selection

Yearbook- we have so many contest entries – we will work with the student council and yearbook committee to choose the overall winner.
