Catholic School Council Financial Statement - Mr. Lococo explained the financial statements.

- finances are spread over different portfolios and are currently being audited
- recent purchases of Lenovo Chromebooks were given to the grade 8 class 9 of the Chromebooks/computers that the grade 8s had were given to other classes in the school
- Mr. Lococo shared with those in attendance that there were Dell laptops purchased last year and these have been deployed to staff for Smartboards, as the COWS computers were not in good working condition
- COW computers have been recycled through the Computer Technology Department

Fundraising Plan

Mr. Lococo discussed the past fundraiser and the current ones in play

- Fresh from Farm Fundraiser quick turnaround sold approximately \$1 400.00 and turned a profit of roughly \$517.00 with the sale of 62 baskets at a cost of \$22 each.
- St. Vincent de Paul Society open from Nov. 23 to Dec 23rd Father Stephen mentioned that with dietary restrictions this is a better way to help support people in the community. This allows the SVDP Society to purchase specific items that they need and balance out the inventory.
- McMillian Cookie Dough and Soup opened Nov. 18 to Dec 5 with the delivery date of Dec 23.

E. STAFF REPORT - Mrs. Wilson

- Empower Training was held for Educational Resource Teachers. This is a program from Sick Kids designed to address reading for students. The Resource Teacher will work with a specific group of between 6-8 students everyday for approximately 115 lessons.
- Empower Training continues for the Educational Resource Teachers.

- EA, ECE, ERT and Principal are participating in Behaviour Management Systems training.
- There is a Professional Development Day on November 25th math and literacy based and full day. St. James will be hosting Assumption, St. Denis and St. Nicolas school staff.
- Mr. Lococo also shared in the meeting that he and Father Stephen got together to arrange dates for St. James students to attend mass at St. Denis Church:

- Capital Projects new outdoor centre for kindergarten students 2023 Mr. Lococo will look into this to see where it is on the schedule.
- Mr. Lococo shared that with our fundraising monies the trip to Joseph and the Technicolor Dreamcoat will have transportation expenses that will be paid for by the school.
- Mr. Lococo shared with CSC members that a budget of \$2,000 was given to the school so that students could attend mass at St. Denis Parish. Father Stephen also shared that NSTS are also willing to support and help transport students to and from St. Denis Parish.
- Father Stephen offered to help support staff for various things ie. celebrating Saints by coming into the classroom.
- Mr. Lococo has shared that the Grade 8s have secured a date for graduation at Club Roma and will be attending Canada's Wonderland for their year end trip
- Mr. Lococo also asked parents to offer ideas for end of the year fundraisers.
