- 3. Catholic School Council Financial Report: total remaining from last year \$400.00. School Budget numbers: \$17, 233.00; some money has gone to text books and photocopy numbers. Council budget monies carries over: \$1193.00
- 4. New staff members: Mrs. Olsson, Mrs. Haywood,
- 5. Monies spent to date: All students 1 to 8 a 'Math Up' workbook @ 14.95 per student. Chromebooks (\$489.00 per unit) ordered from last year to achieve a 1:1 ratio. Purchasing the Smart Board for the Grade 8 room --- or \$ (\$3000 \$4000 potential cost) spent to move board from old room.
- 6. **Food Days**: cost of food days have gone up. Look into a tray of pizza so kinder can order 1 slice and grade 6 can have 4 slices or whatever. Will help cut back on boxes in recycling. May need help distributing slices. **Tuck Shop**: any other options for cookies? Local options? DADS oatmeal cookies that are prepackaged.

Opening school mass/Thanksgiving mass October 5th 2023. This mass will be held in the gymnasium. Parents are welcome to attend.
