E. STAFF REPORTS

- 1. Plant Sales Vermeers in Welland were concerned about trying to run a campaign with families able to go to Food Basics on Hartzell Rd. and purchase (inferior) baskets at a lower price. Miss Nardelli offered to investigate Sunshine Gardens for future poinsettia and spring flower sales.
- 2. Play Day BBQ 360 hotdogs and buns are required. Miss Nardelli will verify that we have enough buns. Mrs. Davies will purchase wieners. Freezies are already purchased and frozen in the school chest freezer. Sue will BBQ the hotdogs at home and then they will be put into the buns at school.
- 3. CSC Annual Report 2014-15 members reviewed the report prior to its submission to the Board. We will raise the price for the *Poinsettia Sale* to increase our profit margin.

The *Christmas Raffle* earned \$1150, but the time and effort required to get the licensing and to produce the gift baskets was substantial. There needs to be serious consideration about running this next year and an equitable division of the labour required.

With 19 *Hot Lunches* earning almost \$2900, we will schedule them every 2 weeks beginning first thing in September. Pasta earned very well (\$300-\$400/day) so Miss Nardelli will ask the St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Women's League if they are interested in assisting us with pasta/soup days. We will try a sub day and a pita day, but they have not earned as much traditionally.

We will look for opportunities to run the *Positive Parenting Program* again next school year. Mr. Demers will inquire with the Public Health Nurse.
