- Possible fundraiser is a cash prize lottery/everyone is able to participate-affordable for most, we have a lottery licence // we would have to look at the amounts for the prizes based on our school//there is work to monitor the return of tickets/can have incentives to have tickets returned & sold
- Taekwondo a possible fund raiser/comes into the school, provide 1 lesson, then students can buy classes for 4 for \$20 // money goes back to the school// Mrs. Ruggi Dietsch has a contact if interested//no minimum amount of participants to make this work//council finds it a good idea to pursue
- Colleen: Cobbs bread fundraiser is popular, not sure of the return back to the school//you get a card \$25 for 12 loaves of bread//will need to investigate what the school will make from it//you can't get 2 loaves a day but you can use the card all in one month, will have restrictions attached
- Need to purchase a tv-80 inch, looking for anyone who can get a discount, also we need a carpet for the library
