Catholicity

- We had our first school mass at the church. Moving forward with our monthly masses, they will be split between the church and the school.
- We had our parent meeting for students receiving their first Holy Communion and First Reconciliation at the church on September 26 at 6:00 pm.
- The parent meeting for our grade 8 students being Confirmed is at the church on October 9 at 6:00 pm.
- Last week, we focused on Truth and Reconciliation in our classrooms.
- Today was Orange Shirt day and again, classroom discussions were had on the importance of this day.

Student Achievement

- We are in the process of creating our Math Action Plan for this school year.
- New this year, we are also creating a Literacy Action Plan.
 - These are both due November 1st. Teachers are in the process of gathering student data to help us outline the plans.
- Data is collected through our EQAO results, Knowledgehook diagnostics and doing Literacy Screeners. These screeners are mandatory for students in year 2 kindergarten to grade 2. They are available to grades 3 6 teachers as well. There are pencil & paper screeners for the grades 7 & 8.

- Our grade 1 teacher, Mrs. Hogben, has reported seeing this year's class being stronger in Literacy because these students have had 2 years of Hagerty and UFLI.
- All teachers are in the process of completing these screeners and diagnostics.

School Activities

- We raised \$3,225 for Terry Fox
- We will be doing a "We Scare Hunger" food drive the whole month of October
- We will have our Halloween Dance-a-Thon on October 31st
- This year, we will be looking to build up our sporting/gym equipment. I have been working Mrs. Morrison to determine our needs for purchasing.
- I have already purchased two Pickleball sets that will be used with the Intermediate classes and the staff after school.
- We are looking to bring in a curling presentation and purchase curling "rocks" designed for use in a gymnasium.
- We had 20 new Chromebooks to start the year. Mrs. Morrison distributed them to classes and we are now at a point where we have a 1:1 ratio for grades 3 8.
