#### C. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

#### 1. Niagara Catholic Parent Involvement Committee (NCPIC) Report

Last meeting was Jan 7, 2016. The meeting was about board technology. There have been several upgrades to the network, firewall, and other infrastructure (to the school board system). Smartboard roll out is in progress for the schools.

Leading Student Achievement (Provincial project)

There is a board team, and a board plan has to be submitted.

St. Charles and Monsignor Clancy are both involved with the project. It provides extra funding (release time, resources)

Proposal – Grade 3-6 classes are part of Reading Leads (word study, reading comprehension).

The project will involve co-planning, between the two schools. The focus of the project is reading. There are multi layers to reading instruction (how to read, to reading comprehension, look to where they are struggling – word development) and the team will focus on developing these strategies. Initially the program will focus on specific classrooms and then will spread to the remainder of the grades.
