C. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- 1. Celebration of Life April 27th
 - All were invited to the open house at our school library to commemorate Marian Yedinak our library technician who passed away. The celebration of life will be held 3:15-5:00 p.m.
- 2. Rankin Run Once again St. Alfred will organize "Team Yedinak" on May 27th
- 3. School Cash on Line all payments over \$2.00 must be done using cash on line. Our secretary Shelley will make herself available to assist any parent having difficulty registering.

- 4. Kindergarten Open House May 31st all new Kindergarten students will be invited to the school to meet their new teachers and participate in transition activities.
- 5. Registrations May 3 Open House: We will be hosting our 3rd Open House to encourage Kindergarten registrations for any child turning 4 by the end of 2017.
- 6. Metro Grant: \$1000.00 –With a partnership with the Holy Cross construction technology class we will be installing a raised garden. Students will be planting vegetables.
