THE PASTOR'S CORNER

We are starting a new three month schedule on January 11th (the old schedule expires January 5th). Ideally, I look for volunteers to minister in once a month, depending on the ministry. This would mean we would need 8 readers, 8 eucharistic ministers and 12 hospitality ministers in our roster. Here is a chart listing our current roster of ministers:

As you can see from this list, some of our ministries a bit overloaded, which is fine, it just means that ministers won't be scheduled that often, which is not ideal. So, as you can see, we could use a few more hospitality ministers and a few new readers particularly at the 8:00 Mass. The rest is well covered. If you would like a break, let us know as well by contacting the office. Just know how valued your service is! The only other ministry which is not yet included here are altar servers. I will be putting a push at the schools in December for new altar servers, if you know anyone who would like to serve, let us know at the office.

In terms of other "non-liturgical" ministries, we are also looking for one more team of 3 to help count the collection (Sundays at 10:30 am or Monday's at 9:00 am (which is preferred). We are also in need of one or two more teams to help with our bereavement ministry - bereavement ministers help prepare our funeral liturgies by meeting with the families, selecting readings, providing a bit of biographical information for the presider and just being a general support. Bereavement ministers *do not* provide grief counselling. Both bereavement and counters will need to provide references, a police check and a brief interview.

Please contact the office or fill out a volunteer form which are located all over the church, or chat with one of our current ministers about it. Also, if you are serving in any of our ministries and you have a family member who would like to serve, let us know that as well. Meanwhile, thank you for all you do in providing ministry to our parish.

THINKING OF STUDENTS IN NEED AT CHRISTMAS

Christmas is a joyous time of year for most, but with families facing financial hardship it can be anything but merry. It's hard to believe that every day, one in five students goes to school hungry and waits in line to receive a breakfast. For lunch some eat pizza scraps from the previous night's supper. During the 2017-2018 school year, in 54 programs, over one million meals were served in our schools to hungry students. A donation of \$13.75 will provide a needy student with a breakfast and nourishing snack daily for a school week.

Other statistics reveal that 80% of classroom learning is done through the eyes, and that one child in four suffers from some kind of vision problem severe enough to impact learning. Many students do not have the financial resources to purchase eye glasses. Several others lack daily essentials such as warm clothing, personal care items, or the financial means to pursue a rewarding education. We often associate poverty with third world countries, little realizing that it exists right here at home in our own backyard.

In his scripture writings about the Lord's judgement of the nations the apostle St. Mathew tells us about the words of Christ when he speaks of feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, giving drink to the thirsty and welcoming the stranger. Christ says, "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are my brothers, you did it to me".
