Dear Parents/Guardians

St. John Henry Newman will be holding a School Triathlon Fundraising event this coming October 29th, which will involve all students who will participate in at least three different activities throughout the day. Students will be involved in a combination of activities including: dancing, reading, Christian Meditation, arts & crafts & walking. The Student Council is busy preparing the music for this event and are very excited to be able to take a leading role in this activity.

Students are asked to attain pledges (\$\$) from their family members and or neighbours/friends. Once all of your pledges have been collected, parents can submit the total collected onto their wallet in the SchoolCash on-line. All students will receive 3 Free Ballots for various Penny Raffle style prizes. In addition, for every \$5.00 that students bring in as part of their pledges, they will receive one additional ballot that they can use for the Penny Raffle. For example, if a student brings in \$40.00 in pledge money, they will receive 3 free ballots plus 8 additional ballots. Therefore, the more money students raise, the more ballots they receive.

As well, for every \$40.00 that a student raises, they will receive one ballot to enter into a draw for a Grand Prize. For example, if a student collects \$40.00 in pledges, they will receive 3 free ballots and 8 additional ballots for the Penny Raffle & 1 ballot for the Grand Prize draw.

At the end of the Triathlon Drive (Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>) students will be provided with their ballots and will be invited to place them in the various Penny Raffle buckets that will be displayed. There will be a special bucket for our Grand Prize tickets and one student will be selected for the Grand Prize and they will be presented with a cheque for \$400.00 to use at their convenience.

All of the money raised from this activity, will be used for the following school items: 50% will be for the purchase of technology; 35% will be used to purchase additional phys ed equipment and 15% will be donated to the Holy Childhood Association. The class that raises the most pledges from K-Gr. 3 will receive a free Pizza Party and the class that raises the most pledges from Gr. 4-8 will receive a free Sub Day.
