Mr. Zanuttini -

- Staffing is the same.
- Plant maintenance- back wall has been painted, as well as the doors.
 Playground game lines and parking lines have all been upgraded for safety and for fun at recess.
- Grade 2 and Grade 8 sacramental prep is occurring monthly with Father Michael with their Learning and Prayer sessions.

- Bullying Awareness There will several activities and lessons led by the classroom teachers, Child and Youth worker.

- Bus Safety prevention video is being watched in all classes
- Advent celebrations will be on each Monday. The celebrations will be virtual liturgies. The first Advent celebration is this Monday.
