JOB FAIR AND CAREER EXPO

The experiential learning program designs opportunities for students to explore their interests and discover their abilities to succeed in all academic pathways and across industry sectors. On Wednesday, May 11, a central Job Fair & Career Expo was organized to provide students with insight into their available options in diverse careers and jobs in our region.

Over 300 Niagara Catholic students attended the Job Fair and Career Expo at Club Roma in St. Catharines. This event brought together 43 employers and organizations that were actively looking to hire and promote their industries. The Job Fair and Career Expo targeted Specialist High Skills Major students to increase the program's exposure and highlight the benefits associated with Specialist High Skills Major enrolment.

Along with the Job Fair floor, students also attended two 40-minute speaker sessions. One of the speaker sessions focused on opportunities and possibilities that are available to students in various sectors in the region. Students were educated about current and future trends of employment needs from four representatives from industry associations and economic development offices. In the second session, students were informed about the skills and attitudes required for entrepreneurial success from a young entrepreneur. Students also gained knowledge about financial programs available to help them start their own ventures from a small business enterprise centre.

The event was well received by employers and attending staff. Most importantly our students felt that the event was beneficial, especially those who either secured employment on that day or scheduled interviews for future employment.

REPORT TO THE BOARD MAY 24, 2022

NIAGARA CATHOLIC AND OECTA NIAGARA ELEMENTARY UNIT BALANCED/ALTERNATIVE DAY JOINT PILOT INITIATIVE

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A "balanced/alternative day" refers to the way that the school day is scheduled. Instead of having the traditional morning and afternoon recesses and a longer lunch break, the balanced day may be divided into three 100 minute learning blocks separated by two nutrition breaks of 40 minutes.

As part of the ratified collective agreement between the Niagara Catholic District School Board and OECTA Niagara Elementary Unit, a letter of understanding was signed in which both parties agreed to work collaboratively to explore a "**Balanced/Alternative Day**" schedule.

THE PROCESS

A Balanced/Alternative Day Joint Committee was established with representation from the Niagara Catholic District School Board and OECTA Niagara Elementary Unit. Representatives worked in tandem to create a roll out plan for the Balanced/Alternative Day initiative. The first step of the plan was to gauge interest for this endeavor within all of our elementary schools. When teachers and/or the principal displayed interest in a balanced/alternative day schedule, an information meeting hosted by the school principal and the site OECTA representative took place.

Following the information meeting, a vote by secret ballot was conducted to determine if an invitation should be extended to the Balanced/Alternative Day Joint Committee to make a further presentation to support the balanced/alternative day schedule. Succeeding the presentation, a second vote by secret ballot was conducted. If seventy-five (75) percent of teachers voted in favour of the balanced/alternative day the schedule would be implemented for the 2022-2023 school year.

Near the conclusion of the pilot year, staff at each site will once again vote by secret ballot to either extend the pilot for an additional year or terminate the balanced/alternative day schedule. If the schedule is affirmed after the second pilot year, the voting process shall continue on a bi-annual basis.

PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS

Schools participating in the balanced/alternative day initiative for the 2022-2023 school year include: Alexander Kuska, Our Lady of Fatima (SC), Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Sacred Heart, St. Christopher, St. Edward, St. Joseph (Snyder) and St. Martin Catholic Elementary Schools.

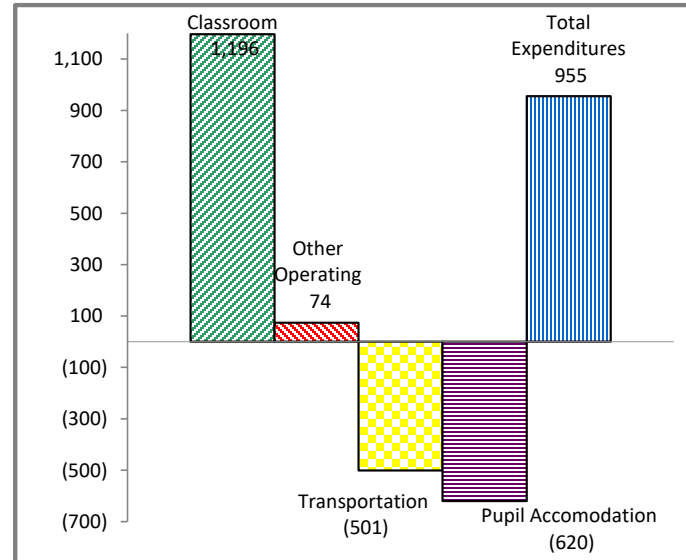

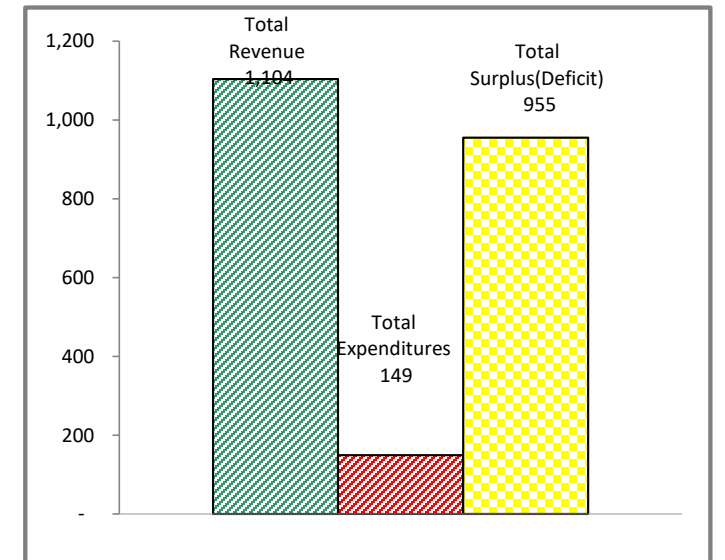
