
HISTORIC POPULATION AND ESTIMATED GROWTH FOR THE NIAGARA REGION

OVERVIEW

The Province has forecast a 2041 Population of 610,000 persons and Employment of 265,000 jobs that Niagara Region must plan for. This represents an increase of 168,000 persons and 80,000 jobs. This is an aggressive target - almost equivalent to the present day population of St. Catharines, Thorold and Niagara-on-the-Lake combined.

Population and employment growth are linked and together provide the opportunity to re-ignite the Regional economy through business development, new housing, infrastructure, research and innovation, and assessment growth.
