 - Immigration, new development and families relocating to Niagara from larger cities.
- 2. What are 3-5 ideas/proposal to help stimulate growth in our Board?
 - Create a welcoming environment for all newcomers.
 - Offer translation services to immigrants to foster a more inclusive and hospitable environment.

- Educate and advertise Catholic education be debunking myths and sharing our story.
- Arrange to have schools open during the summer months to facilitate new registrations in a timely manner.
- Boost the presence of administration in the community to foster relationships.
- Incorporate student testimonials into our marketing strategy.
- Review our Student Admission Policy.
- Promote our schools through our churches and highlight the advantages of a Catholic education to invite other denominations to join our schools.
- Advertise our schools in model homes and encourage real estate agents to promote them.
- Increase social media marketing efforts by sharing activities at our schools.
- Provide more diverse programs.
- 3. What are 3-5 ideas/proposals to help retain students from grade 8 to grade 9 in our schools?
 - Rather than wait until they reach grades 7 and 8 encourage student involvement at a
 much earlier age by giving out school merchandise to promote their secondary school
 and arranging field trips during sporting or special events held at their perspective
 secondary schools.
 - Arrange for secondary schools go to participate in leadership programs or provide coaching assistance at elementary schools.
 - Share best practices such as the Notre Dame Family
 - Provide extracurricular activities.
 - Personal reach out to families by administration.
 - Publicly promote the inclusivity and safety of our schools.
