#### French Immersion 2024-2025

The Niagara Catholic District School Board is proud to offer parents and students the opportunity to enroll in a French Immersion (FI) Program. The French Immersion Program is designed specifically for students whose first language is not French. French Immersion in the Niagara Catholic District School Board is an optional program. The entry point for September 2024 is Kindergarten Year 1 at Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Elementary, St. Catharines.

All students enrolled in the French Immersion Program will be provided with transportation to their local Family of Schools designated French Immersion School site in accordance with the Board's Student Transportation Policy #500.2.

French Immersion On-line Open Pre-Registration window for students new to French Immersion in September 2024 is Monday, January 15th, 2024 at 7:30 a.m. through to Friday, February 2nd, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. Pre-registrations outside of this window will not be considered. There are a limited number of spots available for students wishing to enter the French Immersion Program. An account must be created first through Edsembli to access preregistration forms. Pre-registrations are on a first come, first serve basis. Each pre-registration will receive a time-stamp. Please visit www.niagaracatholic.ca and click the French Immersion banner or "Register Now" then, click the French Immersion tab for information about the program. Additional pre-registration details will be posted on this site as they become available. Please check the site before the pre-registration window opens.

#### **DISMISSAL PROCEDURE**

Parents picking up their child(ren) will continue to meet their child(ren) at the East field during dismissal. Please know that parking spaces in our parking lot are limited: therefore, parents are encouraged to arrive early (approximately 2:40 -2:45) and park at the Church that is next door to the school as there is ample space there. Parents are reminded to please use the sidewalk when walking to and from the East field, regardless of whether they parked their vehicle at the school or Church next door. Please know that walking across the parking lot, especially with children, is not advised as this presents a great concern for safety with vehicles coming in and out. In addition, once the snow arrives and the parking lot is plowed. there will be snowbanks along the edge where the East field and parking lot meet. Again, we remind families to please be safe and utilize the sidewalk. We thank everyone for their continued support and flexibility and for working with the school as we endeavour to keep everyone safe. Please know that we will communicate with families via School Messenger should the dismissal procedure need to be adjusted in any way to account for the challenges of winter.

#### **INDOOR / OUTDOOR FOOTWEAR**

Parents are reminded to send a pair of indoor shoes with their child to school. This will help to keep our school clean. We thank everyone for their cooperation with this matter.



#### **Dental Screening**

Niagara Region Public Health Dental Program will be providing <u>Dental screening</u> to all grades on January 10, 11 &12, 2024.

A registered dental hygienist will take a quick look in the child's mouth using a sterilized mirror and light. Staff will be wearing a mask, eye protection, gloves and performing hand hygiene between each student.

The <u>Healthy Smiles Ontario</u> program may financially assist children who do not have access to dental care.
