Schedule for 2024-2025

For the 2024-25 school year, Mary Ward Elementary School will have an earlier start time and a later dismissal time, as well as a balanced day schedule.

Our <u>school start and end times</u> are reviewed each year by NSTS to ensure transportation services are the most efficient. Bell times will impact bus pickup and drop-off times. This will be communicated by NSTS during the regular process for the 2024-2025 school year and will be made available on the NSTS Portal in mid-August. The morning bell will ring at <u>8:35 AM</u> and the dismissal bell will ring at <u>2:55 PM</u>.

Supervision will start every morning at 8:25 AM and all students are welcome to enter the school at that time.

Our new **school balanced day** schedule is designed to enhance learning, foster healthy habits, and encourage daily physical activity.




