#### Called by Name: Hear My Voice Monthly Reflection





#### **Daily Schedule for 2024-25**

For the 2024-25 school year, Notre Dame Elementary School will have earlier start and dismissal times, as well as a balanced day schedule.

Our <u>school start and end times</u> are reviewed each year by NSTS to ensure transportation services are the most efficient. Bell times will impact bus pickup and drop-off times. This will be communicated by NSTS during the regular process for the 2024-2025 school year and will be made available on the NSTS Portal in mid-August. The morning bell will ring at **8:10 AM** and the dismissal bell will ring at **2:30 PM**.

Our new **school balanced day** schedule is designed to enhance learning, foster healthy habits, and encourage daily physical activity.

A typical Monday to Friday Balanced School Day at Notre Dame Catholic Elementary School will be:

- ⇒ **7:55 student drop-off** (this may vary based on bus arrival times)
- 8:10 8:20 AM School day morning routines
- 8:20 10:20 AM 120 instructional minutes
- ⇒ 10:20 -10:40 AM 20 minute physical activity break (recess)
- ⇒ 10:40 11:00 AM 20 minute nutrition break
- 11:00 12:20 PM 80 instructional minutes
- ⇒ 12:20 12:40 PM 20 minute physical activity break (recess)
- ⇒ 12:40 1:00 PM 20 minute nutrition break
- 1:00 2:20 PM 80 instructional minutes
- 2:20 2:30 PM School day dismissal routines

#### <u>School Messenger - Safe Arrival</u>

One of our greatest priorities is ensuring that all our students arrive safely to school each and every day. School Messenger allows parents to report their child's absence quickly and conveniently using the **mobile app**, a **website**, or an **interactive toll-free phone line** to report an absence, late arrival or early departure, in advance. This process allows the school to verify student attendance and notify parents of an unreported student absence efficiently.

If your child is marked absent and the absence hasn't been explained in advance, our SafeArrival system will contact you to get a reason for the absence.
