- 1. Faith Formation need a parish rep for council Dorothy Murtaugh volunteered. We are awaiting the appointment of our new parish priest.
- 2. Fundraising Opportunities Costco Pies We are exploring possible local options for pies as Betty's is unable to accommodate us this year. Carlee will contact Pie Guys, Mrs. Anderson will contact La Dolché, Kelly K will contact Sophia Sweets Cafe and Mrs. Flagg will follow up with Half Baked. All information will be shared back with Mrs. Turcotte to determine who will supply our Thanksgiving pies this year. Halloween Dance-a-thon huge hit with the students last year, raise almost \$6000, need to purchase more novelty glow items, lots of glow sticks left but students wanted to purchase multiple "fun" items as well. Student council will continue to provide the set up with help from the Spirit Squad. Parent volunteers will be requested to support the sale of glow items and food items. Big Red Fundraiser was a great success again last year, raising \$4000, we will repeat this again in May before the long weekend. We discussed using Tendercuts but since their meat is from Big Red, their price point is higher., Wine again? We will follow up with Laura B friend from last year to see if this is an option for us again this year. This fundraiser gave us just under \$800. May push the date back further away from the Dance-a-thon to elevate money spending for families. Advertise what is available at the meet the Staff night and then pick up orders at the Gingerbread House night. Bench Brewery? Gift Card Raffle for Camp Medeba - Grade 8. Repeating this Grade 8 Fundraiser again this year - very successful for our Grade 8 students -

greatly reduced the cost of the trip. Will do it in the month of April again. We will possibly look into a LeMaze Meat draw (similar to the Optimist Club) - this fundraiser has done very well for the Optimist Club but is dependent on a donation from them. They did donate \$500 to our Nutrition Program Last year.

- 3. Food Days Thanksgiving Luncheon (October 5th)Lakeshore will do our potatoes, Tendercuts will do our turkey. We will request donations from each grade for the remainder of the food and will ask for parent volunteers to support the cooking and distribution of food., Belmont Pizza, PC Italian Club Pasta, Archie's Subs and Pita Pit. Every Thursday with Pasta on the last Tuesday of the month. Research into Hot Dog Day, Taco Tuesdays and a possible French Fry Day for this school year.

We will look to add additional community events from January to April possible movie night for example.
