The Mill Update

-SJB post on our cash online.

The specific customer name can be written once distributed to families.

-The Mill is requesting paperwork that has the following information:

2. Students Name (ex Ella Di Bartolomeo)
3. The total amount of gift certificates purchased with the specific amount for each certificate.

-Once The Mill has information they will:

1. Write out gift certificates
2. Provide SJB certificates with all certificates organized into bags (ex Grade 1 Tomassini)

-The Mill will invoice SJB with the total amount of gift certificates purchased.

-The Mill will donate back a total of 15% of the total sales

-Sale dates posted on cash online
