## **B.** Chair's Report/Presentations

- 1. Health & Safety Protocols / School Re-Opening Plan
  - Mrs. Pozzobon and Mrs. Ruggi Dietsch reviewed our Re-Opening Plan
  - Mr. Cardamone stated that Mrs. Ruggi Dietsch was part of the NCDSB Re-Opening Task Force and Mrs. Pozzobon along with other staff are part of the Loretto Catholic Health and Safety Team. Together our team met at various points throughout the summer to determine all safety measures were put in place.
  - Mr. Cardamone explained that morning drop off and pick up has been better but we continue to see families not distancing
  - Mrs. Griffiths stated that she sees a lot less traffic in the morning, better general flow of traffic at the front of the school.
  - Mrs. Karagiannis stated that she drops off at Parkside and that has been going well too. KSD is on their side of the field until 8:30 am.

## **D.** <u>PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:</u>

1. Welcome: To Sarah Pillitteri (Kinder), Ashley McFarland (CYW), Alexis Malone (EA), Elizabeth Murphy-Semple (Grade 5 & 6); Marina Korce (Grade 6).

2. Vetting of Policies: The following Policies and Administrative Guidelines are currently being reviewed as part of the cyclical Policy and Administrative Guidelines Review process. Dress Code - Secondary Uniform Policy (302.6.6); Elementary Standardized Dress Code Policy (302.6.10); Niagara Catholic Parent Involvement Committee Policy (800.7); Accessibility Customer Service Policy (800.8.1); Complaint Resolution Policy (800.3). 3. Faith Theme: We will continue with our three year theological theme entitled, Seeds of Faith: Mass, Mercy, Mission with a focus on Mission. Our theological theme will once again direct such elements as the daily prayer and faith formation sessions.

4. Meet The Teacher/Classroom Communication: Following our September staff meeting, classroom teachers shared ways they would connect with families. As you can see on the Google Chart, a variety of creative opportunities to connect with families were presented. As always, feel free to reach out to your child's classroom teacher and plan future opportunities to discuss your child's progress, whether on the phone or virtually.

5. Fire Drills/Hold & Secure/Lockdown: Emergency procedures are in place and practiced in all Niagara Catholic schools throughout this school year. We continue to be required to conduct 6 fire drills and 2 hold & secure / lockdown drills each year. This year during our Fire Drills and Hold & Secure, students will remain physical distanced within their environment and classrooms and we will continue to follow both school and provincial health guidelines to ensure everyone's safety.

6. Terry Fox Walk: Loretto Catholic once again supported cancer research through 'walking' for Terry Fox. Our teachers shared information and videos of Terry Fox's journey. Students and staff walked through the neighborhood on September 25, 2020. Loretto Catholic raised \$1015.00 for the cause. Thank you to our community for donating and thank you to Mrs. Lucisano and Mr. Lennox for their leadership.

7. Chromebook Purchases: We have purchased an additional 45 Chromebooks for student use. The cost of the Chromebook purchase was \$13, 221.00. Catholic School Council fundraising funds were used to pay \$6240.00. We are awaiting the return of 11 Chromebooks from the 67 borrowed during our Distance Learning Program.

8. Graduation: We held off on Graduation ceremonies and exercises this past June for our Grade 8 graduates with the plan to have something this fall. Please note that we have received recent direction

from the ministry directing School Boards from refraining from these type of group gatherings in the fall. We've been asked that to put plans on hold for the time being. We are awaiting guidelines for elementary schools to use in creating virtual graduations.

9. Communion/Confirmation: St. Thomas More Parish has been communicating directly with families of children who were scheduled to participate in First Communion and Confirmation. First Communion is scheduled on September 27th, October 4th and October 18th. Confirmation is scheduled for October 24th.

10. Halloween: On Friday, October 30, 2020 the students of Loretto Catholic School will be celebrating Halloween. This day will be designated an alternate dress day and students may wear black and orange or dress in costume. Students are to come to school in costume or black and orange. Parents will not be permitted within the school. Due to the COVID 19 restrictions, there will not be a parade this year. As per our re-opening plan, parents are asked not to send any Halloween treats for the class as they cannot be shared with other students. We realize this is not the usual way we celebrate Halloween at Loretto Catholic but again this is an unprecedented year and we will make the best of the situation. Thank you for your co-operation and understanding.
