- EQAO Results Grade 3: Reading-100%, Writing-100%, Math-100% (Board: Reading-80%, Writing-73%, Math-65%), (Province: Reading-72%, Writing-65%, Math-59%) Grade 6: Reading-100%, Writing-100%, Math-73% (Board: Reading-85%, Writing-84%, Math-51%), (Province: Reading-83%, Writing-83%, Math-49%)

can learn from each other in the way they come to an answer. We also want all our students engaged in Knowledgehook – online mathematical program.
