Lent:

Ash Wednesday marks the start of the Liturgical season of Lent where we not only look at what we can "give up" during the 40 days but also what we can do for others. Almsgiving is an important trait to teach and explain to students so they are aware that they can be of service to others by helping out more and not expecting something in return as Christ did for us. Fr. Stuart will be coming to Sacred Heart on Wed. Feb 14 in the afternoon for the distribution of ashes and a short student-led liturgy will be prepared.

Sacramental Preparation:

We are awaiting word from Fr. Stuart on the dates for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Fr. Stuart has indicated in the past that sacramental preparation and registration will be handled by the church. STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Literacy & Numeracy:

Both Literacy and Numeracy skills continue to be a focus of the staff at Sacred Heart Catholic as it pertains to student achievement. As we continue to implement the consistent use of Board wide purchases such as MathUP Classroom for Teachers and MathUP School for administrators, as well as Knowledgehook that strives to help identify specific learning areas where students may not be achieving to grade level and provide staff with relevant and timely data (including teacher resources) to address misconceptions and errors. Staff are encouraged to utilize pedagogical practices that best reach students where they are at and move them to progressing forward in their acquisition of Literacy and Numeracy curriculum expectations.

Our next PA Day (Friday Feb 16) will continue to include professional development opportunities for our staff in Literacy and Numeracy along with a Virtual Keynote speaker in the area of Equity and Diversity as well a presentation on Student Violence Prevention and Reporting.
