#### **INTRODUCTIONS**

1. **Welcome:** Our newest addition to the Notre Dame staff is Miss Armenti (FSL & P&P) who started in early October.

#### **CATHOLIC FAITH, COMMUNITY, CULTURE**

- 1. **School Mass:** Students have been attending weekly divisional masses with the community at the Our Lady of the Scapular Church on Wednesday mornings at 9 AM. Every 4<sup>th</sup> week, the school will attend mass together. Fr Michael and Fr. Daniel are very visible to your students by visiting classrooms and discussing different aspects of their faith.
- 2. **Family Advent Mass:** Students, parents and staff are invited to attend a Family Advent Mass on Tuesday, December 13 at 7:00 PM at Our Lady of the Scapular Church. There will be a social in the school gym after with light refreshments.
- 3. **Holy Childhood Association Walk:** Notre Dame held its annual Holy Childhood Association Fundraiser in October. Our community raised close to approximately \$420 to support the needs of families worldwide. Thank you to the community for donating.

- 5. Advent Food Drive: Our school will be running our Advent Food Drive from December 5-16
- 6. **Student Voice Faith in Action Team (FIAT) and Student Council:** Students in Gr 4-8 have the opportunity to join the FIAT Team or be elected to Student Council. This team will work with our student council to complete school initiatives and promoting our student body to be active members in our faith. We have registered to become a Development and Peace School. The program encourages school communities to nurture three fundamental and interconnected relationships: our relationship to God, to each other and to the natural world. The FIAT team will work to complete these school initiatives.

### **SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT**

#### 1. Notre Dame School Improvements:

- **Classroom Displays:** 65" TVs were bought for 3 Kindergarten classrooms to be used as classroom displays. Bingo fundraising money was used to cover the expenses of the TV and wall mounts.
- Whiteboards: Classrooms are changing over from blackboards to whiteboards

#### **PATHWAYS**

1. **Extra-Curricular Activities:** Over the last few months, students have represented our school in the following activities: intermediate soccer, cross country, Intermediate Volleyball, and Junior Basketball. In .December, students

2. **Transition to Saint Paul High School:** Grade 8 students are attending transition activities as part of their transition to our Catholic Secondary School. In the last few months, students attended a football game, the Mukoka Leadership Camp for 3 days, were presented with their course selection sheets, and had the option to attend the Saint Paul Open House. In December, Grade 8s will be attending "Grade 8 Day" on December 14. Our Grade 7s will be attending the Christmas Roadshow on December 16.

## LITERACY/ NUMERACY

- 1. **Professional Development** Teacher Professional Development is focused in reading and math that will positively impact student learning. NCDSB System Coaches regularl visit the school to work with teachers in using emerging strategies with our teachers. The Ed Tech Coach is increasing teacher familiarty with coding, 3D printing and design, and Minecraft. The Literacy Coach is working with our primary staff in using Decodable readers recently purchased. The French Immersion and Math Coach are working with staff on the MathUP program.
- 2. **VexGO/Coding** The school has purchased a VexGo Classroom kit. Students can build robots and code them to complete tasks. Due to the open-ended nature of programming, students will be able to engage in activities to explain their thinking as to "why".
- 3. Focus on Data: A Math Common assessment was administered to students in similar grades. Along with EQAO data, teachers will be able to adjust their teaching to address gaps in student learning.
