### **Catholicity**

*N.C.D.S.B.:* We are entering into the third year of the three year theological theme of "Seeds of Faith: Mass, Mercy, *Mission*." To be "Seeds of Faith" is to embrace the diversity in our schools – to care for and support those who are struggling while upholding and encouraging others in their success.

Sacraments and Mass: Fr. Khrys is communicating directly with the parish in regards to making up the sacraments of Communion and Confirmation from last year. We have been told that attending Mass is not allowed at this time, so Fr. Khrys. and I will be working out a schedule for him to conduct Mass in our school Gymnasium for some of our students.

### **Student Achievement**

*New Math Curriculum:* We have begun to implement the new Math curriculum for this year. Key changes: the new document 1. Social-Emotional Learning Skills; 2. Financial Literacy added. Reporting change is that there will be only one grade in Math with the comments to qualify the student's strengths and areas for growth on their report card.

*Using Data to Drive Assessment:* The staff and administration of St. Mark are in the process of completing our Annual School Improvement Plan that will guide our educational direction throughout this coming school year. There will be three main foci for St. Mark School for the 2020-21 academic year – Mathematics, Science, and Technology.

**Technology in the Classroom:** We are looking to augment the technological equipment that we currently have at St. Mark to allow for the largest increase in student achievement. Seventy-Five Chromebooks were purchased last June and we are in the process of deploying them in classrooms.

**Open House/B.B.Q.:** Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we were not able to host our annual Open House this year. In lieu of the open house, all teachers will be reaching out to all families to discuss each student's transition to their new classroom.

*Terry Fox Walk:* On Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, we took part in the annual Terry Fox Walk for Cancer Research. All classes participated in the walk as we worked together to raise money for cancer research. Thank you for your continued support!

**Hallowe'en:** This year as we adjust to all of the changes happening due to COVID-19, the way that we celebrate Halloween will also have to change. We are happy to let you know that the students are still welcome to wear their costumes to school on Friday, October 30th. However, for students in Grade 4 - 8, they will continue to need to incorporate a mask with their costume. As has been the case every year, costumes that are intended to scare or have blood or weapons are not allowed. Halloween activities will be more theme based activities in the classroom. There can be no sharing of snacks or treats. We will also not be able to have our annual Dance-a-thon fundraiser. We are doing what we can to follow the guidelines from the Ministry and still allowing the students to participate in Halloween at school.

**Student Council:** We will be having our student council at St. Mark again this year. Cole Thompson will be our chair and we will be selecting a co-chair from grade 7 next week. Junior Council will start up next month and will have ECO-school responsibilities again this year.
