Principals Report:

1 case of Covid 19 reported, 4 days into school. It was quickly dealt with. Teachers and Staff were ready to pivot into cleaning/organizing. Niagara Region Public Health dictates the protocol, the school just follows. There is an isolation room, ready to be/is in use as needed. Teachers are doing a great job at wearing their masks. Students alike, are doing a great job. Mrs. Read notes that parents are also being respectful of calling/checking in when children have other minor symptoms.

2 Smart Boards at \$5,000 eacc have been ordered. They will take about 4-6 weeks to arrive. Then the only remaining classroom to update technology will be the 6/7 classroom.

Staff Report:

Classes have settled nicely. Some changes that Mrs Sartor is now full time. Changes perhaps to come to 7/8 class to fill gaps. September things like Terry Fox came, and went.

October's Holy Childhood on October 14th. Classes each themselves will walk. Smart Boards are being greatly used. Orange shirt Day had a great turn out as well. Each classroom has their own door to the outside and teachers are loving using them. St Theresa has been chosen as a pilot school. Only 19 within the Niagara Catholic Board. Empower Reading Program (affiliates with Sick Kids Hospital) 12 kids get to partake, in 2 groups of 6 within grades 2 -5.

New gym equipment from the Board is here. The gymnasium is open and being used by classes. Hand sanitizer before and after is what kids are asked to do.

Father Brian will be doing the 1st Communion, Sacraments, and Gr. 8 Confirmation throughout the month of November.



Food/Nutrition:

Mrs. Read noted \$170 was raised from the Terry Fox Walk/Run. Snack Program was talked about a bit and what it looked like. Each of the classrooms is called down, and then gets to choose what snack/s they want from what is available. (all healthy foods)

Mom's Pantry Fundraiser starts November 4th and goes to November 22nd Items will come in for December 15th the week before we leave for Christmas Holidays

Special Lunches: Aiming to do about 2 per month. The pizzas are great as they come in individual boxes which are easy (and clean) to hand out. Snack bins are in the classes.
