February 12 PA Day

The Professional Activity Day on Friday, February 12, 2021 included multiple sessions related to learning about ABA strategies for students. This included two sessions called "Navigating Tricky Situations Through the Lens of ABA and Mental Health" led by the Mental Health Lead and ABA Lead. The focus for educators and support staff was confidentiality, ethics, trauma triggers and social media boundaries with students. The Professional Activity Day also included 23 sessions related to learning about equity, inclusion, anti-discrimination and anti-racism. We completed our day with NCVLE workshops geared towards the better understanding and navigating through the NCVLE site.

E. STAFF REPORT

Technology

We have four (4) classrooms that do not have SmartTVs as of yet. They are working off of Epson ceiling mount projectors which are devices that project through a laptop onto the whiteboard. These Epsons are beginning to act up and will not last much longer. We cannot replace Epsons as the Board is no longer supplying them and we will have to switch over to the TVs. Interactive Smart TVs are currently \$4,600.00 - \$7,000.00 each, with an installation charge between \$800.00 - \$1,000.00.

Kindergarten Registration

As of right now we have 11 students registered for Kindergarten Year 1 for this coming September. Online registration is available 24/7 through the Board's website. Our first virtual open house that took place January 27th was successful – and unique. Thirteen families joined in virtually, either for the morning session or the afternoon session. I started off with a prayer, introductions and a video, presentations by the K-team were made and questions were answered. One family immediately signed up after the presentation.

We hope to have our Kindergarten Night at the end of May where families can come into the school and visit the classrooms.

Transition to and from virtual/in-class

Three students have moved from virtual to in-class this month. Once child has moved into virtual as well. For the most part, St. James Catholic has been very stable with those leaving and coming.

Father Stephen

Father celebrated a virtual Ash Wednesday Liturgy with us and the staff and students of St. Denis Catholic. Ashes were distributed by sprinkling them on the children's heads.

Sacraments

Waiting to hear back from Father as to how First Reconciliation and Holy Communion will roll out. Confirmation is scheduled for Thursday, April 29th at 7:00 p.m.

Some of the children who are now in Grade 3 have yet to receive the Sacrament of First Holy Communion. I reached out to St. Denis Parish at the beginning of the school year and was told that families would be called by the church. I will reach out again.
