I am going to use the opportunity of this latest lockdown to take some holiday time. The church will be closed, **with no masses, May 5-19 inclusive.** It is my normal practice to cancel weekday Masses when I am on vacation. For this time, I am cancelling Sunday Masses as well because: i) I don't want to burden a guest priest with trying to limit the number of people at mass; ii) the bishop's dispensation from the Sunday obligation is ongoing; iii) so few people are able to attend Sunday Mass during this lockdown that it is not a huge inconvenience; iv) it saves the parish the expense of having to pay a guest priest; v) several parishes have just shut down completely, as the bishop has left it up to individual pastors to decide whether or not to continue having public Masses during the lockdown. I have advised the bishop of this and know that I can count on your understanding. For those who have mass intentions scheduled during this time, I will still be saying Mass for those intentions on the scheduled days. If you wish to change the date, please let me know before May 5.
