#### F. AGENDA ITEMS

- What we know so far about Reopening rules, date TBD These items will be in the Friday update to the community. There are similar rules to September difference being grades 1-3 to wear masks. Updating screening rules may happen. More information to come.
- Masks off during snack time and lunches. This may present challenges. Also, we will be monitoring the students, but they may have underlying conditions. Kindergartens do not have to wear masks. In compliance, we were very successful. COVID fatigue may set in regarding masks after the first few weeks. We can look for strategies to alleviate this.
- Regarding online enrolment the deadline changed to Feb. 23 we can always contact virtual learning to get information or suggestions. Mike F. mentioned how families may think about virtual learning depending on the situation. As a school, we try to accommodate families based on their situation.
- Mike F. commended all the staff during online learning. DPA is done even by family! It has been very engaging for students. The lack of distractions cause students to work quickly. Time management continues to be a challenge.
- Overall, parent feedback has been positive. It is very different from last year more minutes online. Parents now feel they are not missing out on education.
- Many other compliments to OLF staff for the online complement. Staff has been working hard. A big Thank you to all staff.
- Mike F. asked how parents can thank the teachers questions?? App called 'cameo' where actors say something. You can script what they say, and we can wish something nice to the teachers.
- We can look into that also, virtual gift cards, etc.
- Tracy K. thanked the parents for being so engaged.
- Questions double masking? It seems like it will be a personal preference. Once schools open, we may get more direction from local public health.
- Question will kids wear masks at recess? Within 6 feet, students must wear masks.
- Brian P. mentioned that the older students would wear masks outside anyway.
