The results of the survey are in. We had 72 responses. The topic with the most interest is Mental Health and Well-Being. The day of the week with the most votes is Wednesday with 33 votes followed closely by Monday with 32 votes.

There is a presenter available, Al Monachino, who is a Behaviour Resource Teacher with Niagara Catholic who does a presentation that focuses on mental wellness. It will introduce families to the neuroscience behind our brain – how our thoughts produce our feelings and our feelings impact our actions, reactions and behaviours. There will be no cost for this presenter. The \$500 available to access for parent engagement can be used to provide sensory resource kits to families.
