The American perspective makes it easy to appreciate our free ‘public’ Catholic Education. There were connections made to the report provided by Mrs. Roach from the discussion at the last Council meeting pertaining to the Triad of Home, School, Parish. Mrs. Roach reported that Father will do a grade 2 & 8 information meeting and individual family meetings at the school for the upcoming 2016-17 school year pertaining to Sacramental preparation.

***Finalize June 24<sup>th</sup> Free Hot Lunch*** – Miss Nardelli has already purchased the freezies which are in the school freezers. She will order the buns and she will price check the cost of wieners at various retailers. Mrs. Breen checked on line for sales. Mrs. Sticca volunteered to purchase sufficient juice boxes for the lunch. Mr. Demers will purchase condiments. Mrs. Davies and Mrs. Sticca volunteered to ensure that the wieners are cooked and at the school to stuff in the buns by mid-morning that day. Three carts will follow the Hot Lunch Serving Schedule.

There was discussion about Mrs. Sticca looking in to the potential cost of using a local caterer. Mrs. Davies offered to check the cost of using Niagara College Culinary or Club Capri. There was discussion about using a larger community building, if needed.

3) Mrs Sticca suggested that we would need to purchase many additional tables in order to run a Vendor Fair.
