Your Childs Placement

While we made every effort and attempt to ensure all accommodations were considered, there may be some accommodations that we simply could not put into place. **Class placements may change ONLY if enrollment changes**. Other than for that particular reason, we are not able to accommodate any parent requests for changes in class placement.

First Day of School Reminders

Kindergarten children will proceed to the Kindergarten area (fenced in) and will be greeted by their teachers. Parents of Kindergarten children are reminded not to linger as this will increase stress and anxiety levels for students who have difficulty with parent separation.

Parents will not be permitted to exit their car if they are using the kiss and ride lane. If you wish to exit your vehicle and escort your child to the entry door, you will need to park your car.

Eyes Ready for the School Year!

Proper vision is important for a student's learning and social development. A full eye exam by an eye doctor (optometrist) is the best way to ensure a healthy eyes and good vision. <u>The Eye See...</u> <u>Eye Learn®</u> program is for students in junior and senior kindergarten to have a full eye exam (covered by OHIP) with a <u>participating optometrist</u>. If a child needs glasses, they will receive a free pair donated by Plastic Plus, Modern Optical Canada and the participating optometrist. For children aged 19 and under, OHIP covers the cost of a complete annual eye exam and any follow-up assessments that may be required.

A yearly eye exam is recommended – <u>find an eye doctor near you</u>.

Safely Packing Lunches

1. Clean

- \cdot Wash your hands for 20 seconds with soap and water before preparing any meal
- \cdot Make sure you sanitize countertops, utensils and any lunch boxes or lunch bags
- o For surfaces and lunch boxes/bags: mix 2.5 ml (1/2 tsp) of bleach with 1 L (4 cups) of water. o Apply to surface and let stand briefly.
- o Rinse with clean water and air dry or use a clean towel.
- \cdot Wash raw fruits and vegetables before eating

2. Keep Cold Food Cold

 \cdot Meat, chicken, seafood, eggs, and dairy products must stay cold to stay safe. Use frozen packs to keep food at or below 4°C (40 F).

 \cdot Use an insulated lunch bag and place freezer packs between foods that need to stay cold. Refrigerate the night before to get your lunch bag off to a cool start.

3. Keep Hot Food Hot

 \cdot Hot food must stay hot at above 60°C (140°F). Use insulated containers and keep them closed until ready to eat or take your food cold and reheat it.

Grade 7 Immunization Campaign

Niagara Region Public Health's school-based vaccination clinics will begin in September for the following publicly funded <u>routine school vaccinations</u>:

- · Meningococcal
- o Single dose
- o Required for school attendance under the Immunization of School Pupils Act
- · Hepatitis B (HB)
- o 2 or 3 dose series depending on age and health history
- · Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- o 2 or 3 dose series depending on age and health history

Parents/legal guardians of grade 7 students will receive an information package and instructions on how to submit their completed consent form. Parents/legal guardians must complete the consent form whether their child is receiving **all**, **some**, or **none** of the vaccines. More information will be provided through your child's school.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE and SAFE ARRIVAL

Our Lady of Mount Carmel School and all schools throughout Niagara Catholic use the Safe Arrival program to manage student attendance reporting. The Safe Arrival program reduces the time it takes to verify student attendance by making it easier for you to report your child's absence and easier for staff to respond to unexplained student absences. The Safe Arrival program allows parents to report their child's absence quickly and conveniently in one of three ways:

1) Use the SafeArrival website, <u>https://go.schoolmessenger.ca</u>. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account using your email address. After logging in, select the Attendance tab to Report an Absence.

2) Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at <u>https://go.schoolmessenger.ca</u>). Use your new login information to access your account. Select Attendance to Report an Absence. If you would like to receive attendance notifications on your mobile device please enable Push Notifications in the Settings area of the app. The document Using the SchoolMessenger app will give instructions for using the App.

3) The toll-free number 844-287-6287 will allow you to report your child absent without creating an account.

Parking Lot Procedures

- The center lane of our parking lot has a left lane for those not stopping to drop off their children.
- The right side of that lane is our "Kiss and Ride" lane.
- Students are to exit from the right side of their vehicle so as not to open their door to the Drive-Thru lane possibly putting them in danger
- If you need to get out to assist your child, please do not use the Kiss N Ride lane. Please continue to the parking area where it is much safer, and then you can get out and help your child.



• With our growing population, it is imperative that we all understand the importance of utilizing the parking lot with patience and care for one another.

REMINDER- No single serve plastics available

Parents are reminded to ensure that their child(ren) have the required utensils needed to eat their snacks/lunches as well as a reusable water bottle they can fill at the hydration stations. We are no longer permitted to distribute plastic/styrofoam spoons, forks or cups to students that do not have them.
