#### Student Supervision

- Please note all academic periods are 40 minutes in length based on a 5 day cycle
- All students are supervised during lunch and recess periods
- Morning supervision begins with the arrival of the first bus which is 8:55am and concludes with the bus supervision at 3:30pm.
- We ask parents not to leave students at the school before supervision begins
- Any students who arrive before 9:10 are to go to the back of the school.
- Students who arrive after 9:10 are to ring the front door bell to be allowed to enter

### **School Safety**

As Mandated by the Ontario Government Code of Conduct, all schools under the Safe Schools Act are to have **sign in procedures** in place. The Act also requires school boards to ensure that no one other than regular school staff and students be allowed to enter a school building without

signing in at the Main Office and wearing a visitors badge. For continued safety of all students the Niagara Catholic District School Board requires all elementary school entrances be kept locked during the school day. All visitors must visit the main entrance which is equipped with a video camera, a voice intercom/doorbell panel and a door release mechanism. If you are dropping off any items for your child during the school day, please leave them on the cart outside the doors. Thank you for your support in keeping our children safe.



#### **Anaphylaxis**

At St. Edward Catholic, we continue to have several students with anaphylaxis, a severe life threatening condition caused by

an allergic reaction to certain food products (peanuts, dairy, medications, latex products, bee stings etc) Residue on any material that has been touched by hands that have not been properly washed may also trigger a severe allergic reaction. Anaphylaxis requires immediate medical intervention. Classroom teachers who have students with anaphylaxis are working hard to prevent accidental exposure to products that trigger these reactions. We will also be forwarding letters home to parents informing them of the presence of a child with anaphylaxis in the school and requesting that all parents co-operate by not sending specific foods for lunch and snacks that could trigger a life threatening reaction. Thank you in advance for your assistance and co-operation regarding this life threatening matter.

### **REPORT YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE**

The Niagara Catholic Safe Arrival system is accessible to parents/guardians to report their child's late arrival or absence quickly and conveniently.

- Use the SafeArrival website, <a href="https://go.schoolmessenger.ca">https://go.schoolmessenger.ca</a>. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account using your email address. After logging in, select the Attendance tab to Report an Absence.
- Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app (blue logo) from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at <u>https://go.schoolmessenger.ca</u>). Use your new login information to access your account. Select Attendance to Report an Absence. If you would like to receive attendance notifications on your mobile device please enable Push Notifications in the Settings area of the app. The document Using the SchoolMessenger app will give instructions for using the App.
- The toll-free number 844-287-6287 will allow you to report your child absent without creating an account.

### **Updated Information**

It is important that we have the most updated information in our files to ensure we can contact you and send you important

information via email. If you have changed email addresses or phone numbers and emergency contact info, please call the school to let us know. If you are not receiving emails from our school, it means we do not have your correct email on file. Also please update us on any allergies or medical conditions that we should be aware of.

#### **Lunch Time Expectations**

Listed below is a set of routines/expectations that our students are expected to follow during lunch time You will be contacted should your child have difficulty following the routines and expectations.

- Students are to eat at their own desk.
- Students are to remain seated throughout the lunch period
- Students are to keep noise at an appropriate level
- Students may not leave the lunch room with the supervisor's permission
- No electronic devices are accessible during lunch periods unless directed by the classroom teacher.


### No Pets on School Property

In an effort to support an engaged learning environment where students are able to focus their attention, participate in lessons and receive the best education possible, we are adhering to a no cell phone or electronics policy within the classroom. What this means is that teachers will allow cell phones and electronics only when directed and for academic purposes only. Cell phones will be kept in secured areas if students choose to bring them in the classroom. No cell phones or electronics will be allowed outside at recess, to be used during lunch or recess times or any part of the school day unless directed by the teacher.
