

This program enables us to monitor student internet traffic while using Board internet devices. The "Student Aware" program will be identifying and notifying school staff when students access online websites related to suicide, violence, abuse and/or other

dangerous activities. When high-risk incidents are identified, school staff and administration will investigate the occurrence and respond accordingly to support student mental health and well-being.

# Parking Lot Safety Information

As we continue to ensure our parking lot is a safe and secure area for our students to enter and exit the school, we appreciate and request your diligence when picking up your children. School staff will continue to supervise the parking lot area in addition to the playground, however, drivers are required to be extra cautious when picking up, especially during peak traffic times.

The school front and church parking lots are very busy and congested during these times and our students can be hidden behind vehicles.

Church Parking Lot Area: When dropping your child off on the side of the school next to the church, please pull up to the yellow lined area to unload your children. Parents can stay in their vehicles, the children can walk across the yellow lines to the sidewalk and walk down to the playground area. This will allow for better flow in the morning hours when it is busy. Do not pull up and leave your vehicle unattended to drop off your child. This is unfair to other parents who are waiting to drop off their children and it clogs up the parking lot. If you are walking your child through the parking lot, please ensure



that they are close to you and not running ahead. There are numerous vehicles that may not be able to see our students so please take precautions.

<u>Please remember to not park in the handicap parking spots unless you have an authorized card to do so. Please do not park in front of the garbage bin or fence gate where signs are posted for no parking allowed. Kindly use precaution at all times.</u>

#### **NCDSB Dress Code**

NCDSB Dress Code The following serves as a reminder for families as the warmer weather approaches and if dress code purchases are being made. Students must wear the elementary standardized dress code items properly and in compliance with the expectations throughout the school day and at all activities

and events as representatives of the school and/or Board. It is the expectation that students wear the elementary standardized dress code as a condition of attendance in an elementary school within the Niagara Catholic District School Board at a minimum, if the elementary student is not in compliance with the mandatory elementary standardized dress code, parents and guardians will be contacted to bring the required dress code items to school.

At a minimum, every student is required to wear one (1) of the following items:

- · Navy Blue sweat pants for students in Early Learning Kindergarten to Grade 3
- · Navy Blue Pants (Cargo, Corduroy, Denim, Dress, Kobe styles permitted)
- · Navy Blue Dresses or Skorts; or · Navy Blue Capris or Walking Shorts.
- · Grade 8 students have the option to wear grey secondary uniform pants purchased through Board uniform suppliers. Pants, skirt or dress length must be appropriate and modest. Only knee length

capris or shorts are permitted. All clothing must be in good repair.

At a minimum, every student is required to wear one (1) of the following items:

- · Navy Blue or White Oxford shirt (short or long sleeve)
- · Navy Blue or White Polo shirt (short or long sleeve); or
- · School designed spirit wear polo shirt.

The elementary standardized dress code shirts, either polo or oxford must be buttoned in a respectable manner. Visible t-shirts worn under the elementary standardized dress code top must be either navy blue or white.

In addition, approved sweaters and hoodies embroidered and/or screened with the school logo are permitted to be worn as part of the elementary standardized dress code.

Running shoes are the recommended footwear with a full back and a closed toe. It is recommended that parents/guardians provide a pair of indoor shoes for physical education and indoor wear.
