Halloween will be celebrated on Thursday, October 31. Students from Kindergarten to Grade Eight are invited to wear costumes. Students must come to school dressed in costume and be prepared to wear their costume throughout the day. Bulky and cumbersome costumes are discouraged. As well, costumes which reflect violence, excessive gore, or weapons are absolutely not permitted. Any student who does not wish to wear a costume is encouraged to wear orange/black. Niagara Region Public Health Dental Program will be offering Dental screening to grades 2, 4, 7 & JK, SK on Tuesday October 29th.
