1. Land Acknowledgment

- i) 2023-2024 Fundraised \$1,792.93 (COBS \$1,250.00; Mom's Pantry \$97.93; Krispy Kreme Doughnuts \$445.00). Purchased 22 chromebooks at \$8,949.00. \$1,105.00 raised during the Christmas Shoppe. Twenty-two \$50.00 gift cards purchased and given to families to support during the Christmas season.
- ii) Catholic School Council Parent Engagement Funds, to be used by June 13, 2024 \$500.00 with an additional \$1,000.00 in funds to support parent engagement activities at the school level through an application process. First come, first serve basis. Application/funding will be approved in alignment with Ministry criteria in relation to identifying needs for the school community and how schools can improve in at least one the following areas:
- addressing social inclusion and racism specifically anti-Asian, anti-Black, and anti-Indigenous racism and other prejudices toward racialized and marginalized group
- creating a safe and welcoming environment
- informing parents about the expectations of the Ontario Curriculum and supporting resources
- providing workshops for parents/guardians to inspire their children to learn, mental health and well-being, internet safety, cyber bullying and healthy living
- projects to support Indigenous learners and their families
- programs for newcomer families to introduce them to Catholic education in Niagara Catholic
- parent resources and tools in multiple languages to make all parents/guardians and students feel welcome and include
- skill-building opportunities for parents –information sessions/workshops that provide parents with the knowledge, skills and tools they need to support student learning at home and at school
- ** All Sacramental preparation classes will be completed by the church. Letters to Grade 2 and Grade 8 Parents/Guardians to be sent home through Father Ben.
- ** We are still a Math Priority school for Grade 3 and 6, with support from a Math coach throughout the year. If time allows, the coach will hel other's who request.
- ** We have been designated as a Public Health Priority School. As such, our school's Public Health Nurse, Tesha, will be at St. Nicholas Catholic every Monday and Tuesday to offer support as needed.
