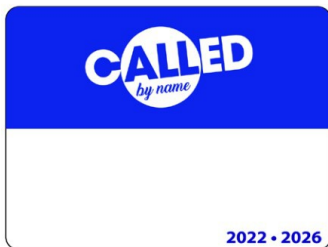
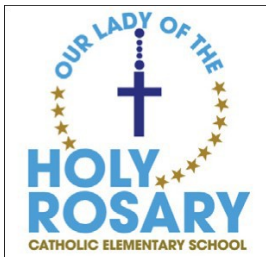


Weekly Update
