- 1. Greeting-V. Wegelin-Mrs. Wegelin greeted everyone present the meeting.
- 2. Land Acknowledgement: The Niagara Catholic District School Board wishes to honour the Indigenous people who have been the protectors of this land, known as Turtle Island, for more than ten thousand years. We begin this meeting by acknowledging the land on which we gather is the traditional territory of the Haudenosaunee and Anishinaabe peoples, many of whom continue to live and work here today. This territory is covered by the Upper Canada Treaties and is within the land protected by the Dish With One Spoon Wampum agreement. Today this gathering place is home to many First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples and acknowledging reminds us that our great standard of living is directly related to the resources and friendship of Indigenous people.

- 7. Principal's Report-V. Wegelin

-Everyone has welcomed very warmly the new staff. Our new staff members are Mr. Biamonte-our grade 3/4 teacher, Miss Brenna Ellens, Mr. Rene Lanteigne, Miss Patrushka Pinkus, Ms. Alison Farrell are our new Educational Assistants. Ms. Amanda Benton is our new Child and Youth Care Worker. -We will be having regular fire drills and lockdown drills at the school. -Our SNAC Program is up and running. We received a grant of \$8438.40 from President's Choice.

-As a school we are continuing to focus on literacy/numeracy as our main focus in academic improvements this year. The Math program that is being used this year is called Math Up. The program has consistent overall expectations throughout all grades and time for consolidation in Grade 8. There are 151 fewer expectations. Foundational ideas develop in the early grades. There are high



impact instructional practices such as direct instruction, learning goals and success criteria, problem solving tasks, math conversations, teaching about problem solving, small group instruction, flexible groupings and deliberate practice. -Short Learning Cycles will be happening in Math. Teachers will be administering pretests and post-testing to see progress with certain curriculum expectations. This data will be brought to meetings to discuss strategies for improvement that could be implemented.

-Junior and Intermediate teachers have received in-servicing on a new program titled Edwin which will assist them in programming for Science, Social Studies and Language.

-Ontario Association for Parents in Catholic Education Representative: In accordance with the OAPCE By-Laws, this parent/guardian must be Roman Catholic, Contact information will be sent to the Board. If someone does not volunteer, this position defaults to the CSC Chair/Co-Chair. Mr. Burtnik is the representative for our Catholic School Council.

-A Catholic School Council Financial Report will be done at our next meeting.

8. Staff Report-T. Lee

-September 20, 2024 is a Professional Activity Day for all staff. There will not be school for students on this day. We will be focusing on Mental Health, Acadience-K-Gr. 2, Math and Literacy Action Plans and RISE which is our new IEP engine.
