 - AGENDA ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:
 - Parent Donated Money to use for needy families: Clothing We can buy food items for a family but we can't buy a gift card for families to use towards food or clothing. Money can be used to buy clothing, though. Is council will to allow the money to be used to buy clothing? Look into vouchers rather than gift cards? Can we look into 'Adopt a Family'? Parents are okay with the money being used to help.
 - St. Francis Mentorship Program Grade 12 Phys.ed class: Will meet with them next Monday.
 - Soccer Survey Results: 26 respondents: Good results. Majority of respondents said their child enjoys playing soccer at recess. And overall a majority of respondents indicated (via a likert scale) that they believe soccer is "A Safe Sport at School".
 - **Privacy:** The school board/province are going to great lengths to protect student and family privacy.
 - Diagnostic Screeners: (Grade SK to 2) Indicator of phonemic awareness. (Acadience Learning)
 This is a provincial screener done 3 times a year. Data will be seen on the Feb. Report card.
