



## SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING

Encourage Your Child's Social and Emotional Learning.

Teaching children healthy coping strategies when they experience big feelings (mad, sad, scared frustrated etc.) is important for their social and emotional well-being and can help prepare them to manage challenges throughout their lives.

Let your child know all emotions are okay. You can help them find healthy ways to express these by:

• Offering hugs and signs of affection when they are upset

• Pointing out the emotions they are expressing, "It looks like you are mad/sad/frustrated..."

• Being there for them when they are ready to talk

• Listening to your child; gently ask them to tell you what is wrong

• Helping your child think of things to do that will help them feel better (such as: practicing deep breathing, kicking a ball against a wall, listening to music, drawing a picture)

If you are concerned about your child's social and emotional health please discuss your concerns with your child's teacher. Your child may need some extra supports that can be made available within the school or in the community.
